

What's Cooking?

GRILLED HAIDA GWAI SALMON WITH CREAMY PESTO SAUCE

Ingredients:

- 4 fresh Haida Gwaii salmon fillets
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1/4 tsp. pepper
- 2 tbsp. olive oil
- 1/4 c milk
- 4 oz. Philadelphia Cream Cheese
- 2 tbs. pesto
- 1 tbsp. finely chopped fresh parsley

Directions:

1. Heat grill to medium heat
2. Brush both sides of fish with oil; sprinkle with salt and pepper. Grill, skin- sides down, 10 minutes or until fish flakes easily with fork
3. Meanwhile, cook cream cheese and milk in a saucepan on medium heat 2 to 3 minutes, or until cream cheese is completely melted and sauce is well blended, stirring constantly. Stir in pesto
4. Serve fish topped with sauce and parsley
