



COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN FOR PEREGRINE LODGE

The Peregrine Lodge operations team is dedicated to providing all guests a unique, unforgettable fishing experience in a pristine wilderness setting. A major component of achieving this goal is ensuring the safety of all visitors to the lodge. As the safety measures surrounding Covid-19 continue to evolve and more information about the nature of the virus comes to light, we will ensure the Peregrine Lodge team is well versed in all guidelines set forth by [WorkSafe BC](#), the government of British Columbia, and the public health authorities. Our main priority is to provide a safe experience for everyone. With this end in mind, we have implemented the following safety protocols to ensure the health and well-being of each of our guests and staff.

TRAVEL

- As is the case with all airline companies, facial masks will be required when traveling to and from Masset on our private charter aircraft, as well as on the helicopter ride to and from the lodge.
- Aircraft will be sanitized before boarding
- Hand sanitizer stations will be set up and available at all points of travel.
- The recommended physical distancing of 6 feet or 2 meters is to be maintained where possible.

THE LODGE

- Facial masks will be required at the lodge when physical distancing is not possible
- Multiple hand sanitizing stations are available throughout the property.
- Staff will ensure high traffic areas and common areas are thoroughly cleaned and sanitized on a regular basis.
- Our dining room has been reconfigured to ensure all parties are safely separated from one another.

ON THE WATER

- We want you to enjoy the outdoors. Masks will only be required when social distancing is not possible.
- All fishing equipment on board will be thoroughly sanitized throughout the day.

PEREGRINE LODGE STAFF

- All Peregrine Lodge staff will be trained in detail on all the health and safety protocols that are implemented on site.
- The physical health of staff at the lodge will be closely monitored on a regular basis.
- Peregrine Lodge staff will be diligent about practicing the recommended physical distancing both while they are at work and during their days off.
